GLVFA officers will also present grant checks from our 2024 donations to deserving local veteran and civic organizations.

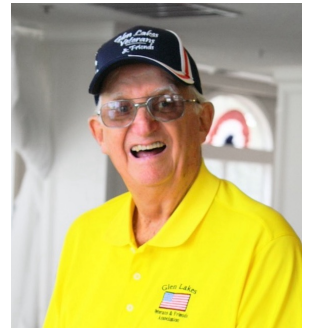
Veterans Memorial "Garden of Honor" Spring 2025 Brick Purchase Campaign
