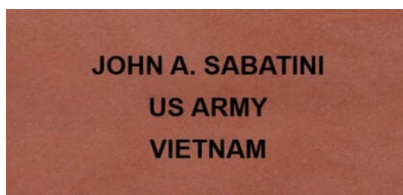
Our various fund raising activities will include great gift baskets, restaurant and retail gift packages and much more. A complementary buffet will be available. Please stop by!

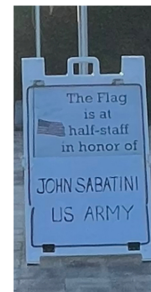
