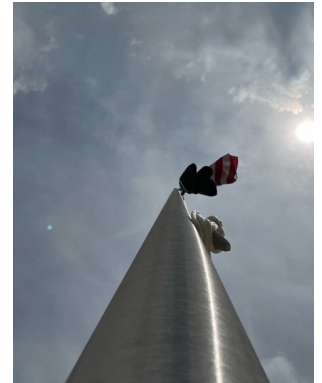

Memorial Day - Monday, May 27th @ 12pm (Noon) at the GlenLakes Veterans Memorial Flag Raising Ceremony

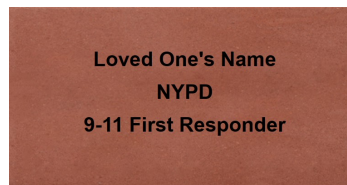
