Mark your calendars for November 7th, 9 am., as GLVFA will hold its next members meeting at the clubhouse ballroom. Two guest speakers this month!

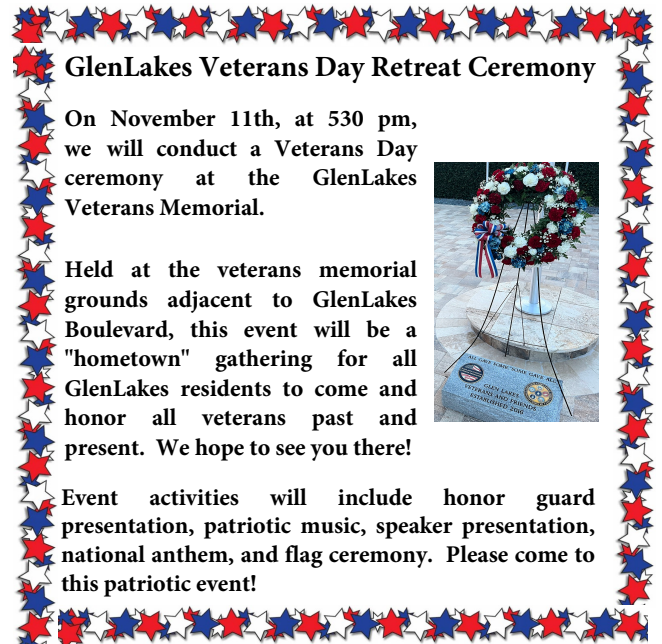
