# GlenLakes Computer Club



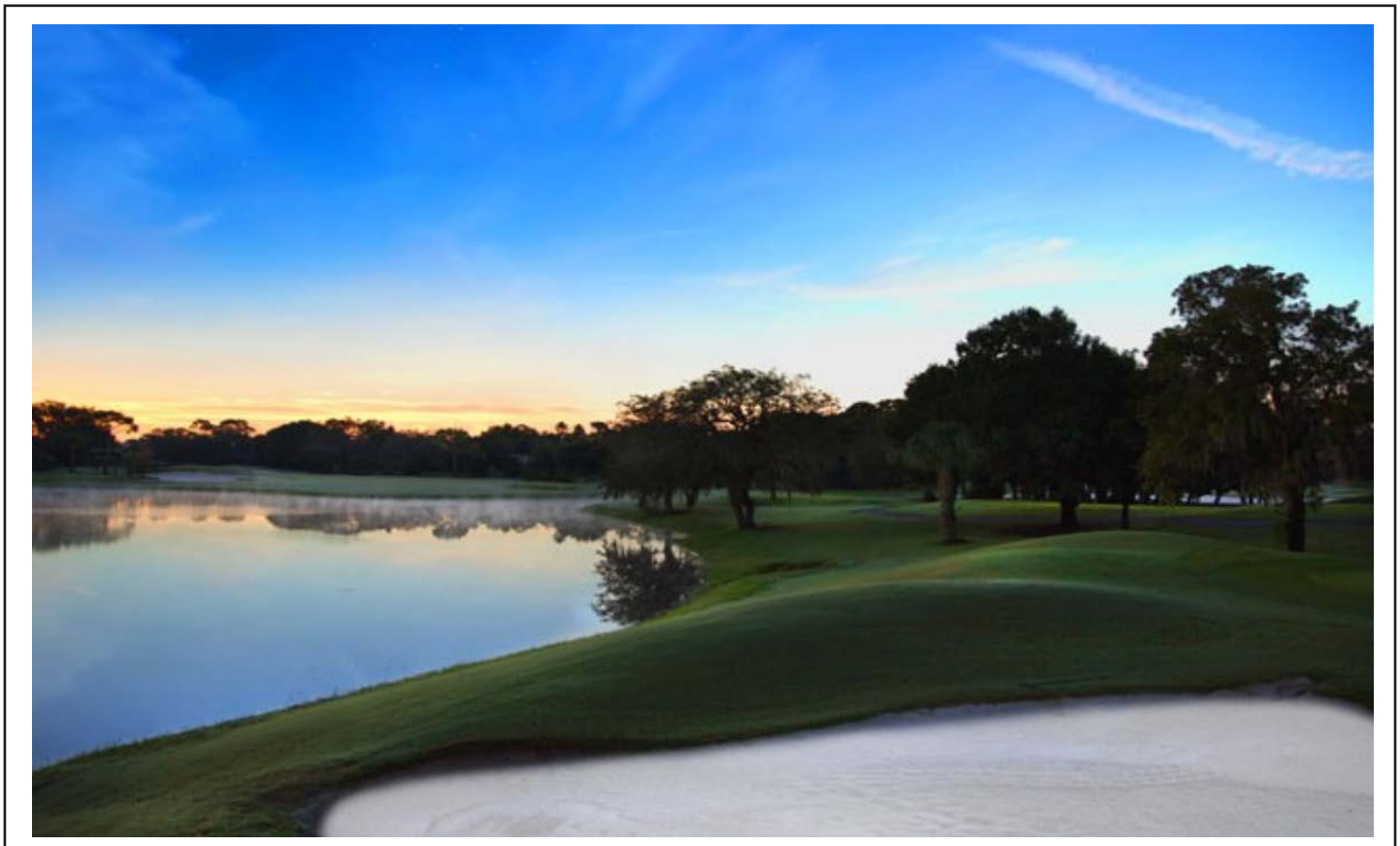

## Control Diabetes and Ways to Stay Active As We Age

Our guest speaker will be Laura Gonzalez Gamba, a certified Master Senior Trainer with the University of Illinois Chicago's Diabetes Empowerment Education Program (DEEP), a certified coach for Tai Ji Quan moving for better balance through the Oregon Research Institute, a certified lay leader for Matter of Balance:



Managing Concerns about Falling through Boston University and a certified Tai Chi for Arthritis instructor through the Tai Chi for Health Institute. Laura will present to the group regarding her services and will be offering free classes to the attendees in the near future.

## What is The DEEP Program ?

The Diabetes Empowerment Education Program, also known as DEEP, is an education curriculum designed to help people with pre-diabetes, diabetes, relatives and caregivers gain a better understanding of diabetes self-care.

*Goals of the DEEP™ curriculum include:*

- Improving and maintaining the quality of life of persons with pre-diabetes and existing diabetes
- Preventing complications and incapacities
- Improving eating habits and maintaining nutrition
- Improving the relationship between patients and health care providers

## SAVES Program for PTSD Vets

The SAVES initiative consists of a 6-week golf academy for PTSD vets.

The new veterans program brings therapeutic hope for veteran golfing enthusiasts. Currently operating at Sweet Swing Golfing Range in Homosassa, FL, the program offers a very high-level of instruction from PGA instructor Joe Cioe. Each participant receives complimentary golf apparel and related sports supplies to do their best on the range. The SAVES program will sponsor four academies each year. VA assistance and counseling is available to ensure progress of all candidates as they enjoy a wonderful sport they enjoy.

On November 16th, Ken White shot a 69. His round included 7 birdies! What an accomplishment!

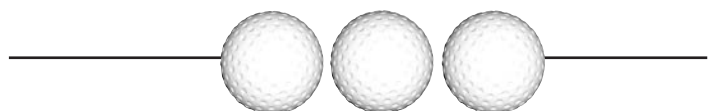
We must also recognize Chuck Jenkins. On November 22nd, using a 5 hybrid club from 152 yards, Chuck aced hole #7.
